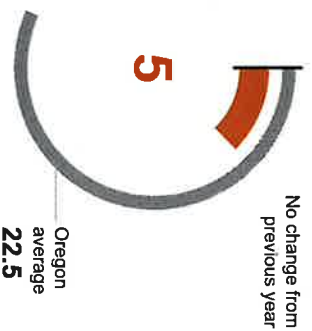

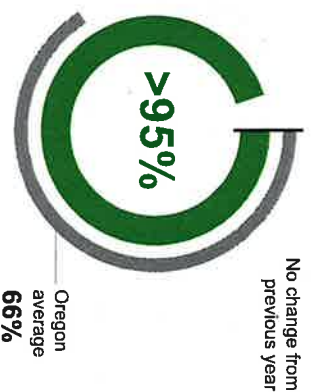
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

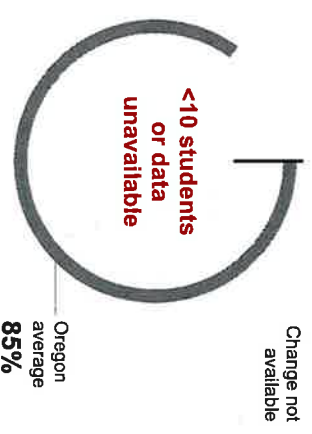

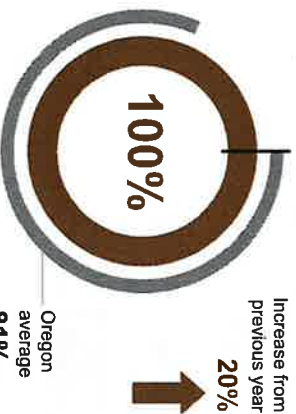

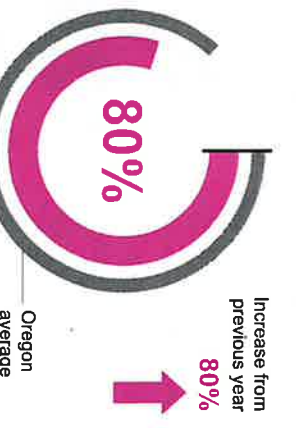

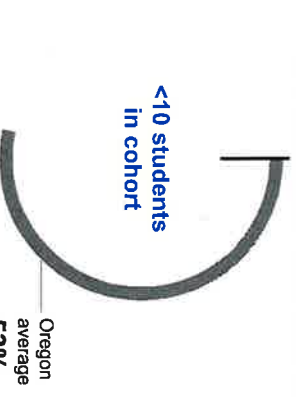
FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

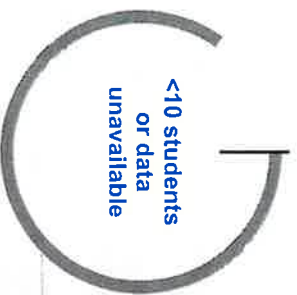

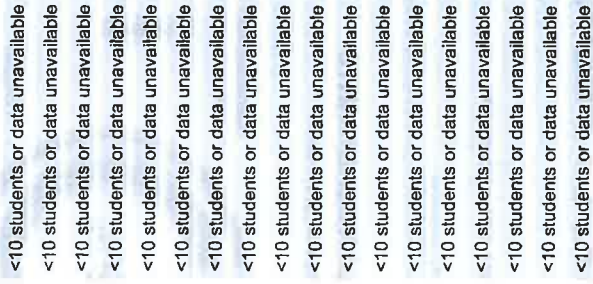
